- Available for the Master of Public Policy or Master of International Affairs
- Open to applicants of all nationalities
- Up to two full scholarships available, each worth 32,500 EUR
- Scholarship recipients play an active role in IGYLF during the scholarship period
- The deadline to apply is 1 March

Who is it for?

Applicants with demonstrated interest in Indo-German relations, either academically or professionally, and who wish to pursue a degree in public policy or international affairs.

How to apply

- 1. First, submit a standard application to the MPP or MIA programme.
- 2. Additionally, write a one-page personal statement detailing your interest in furthering the relationship between India and Germany.

Interested applicants should submit their applications and motivation statements **before 1 March**. Shortlisted candidates will be contacted for an interview.
